Legal Basis of the EJN



- Council Decision 2001/470/EC of 28 May 2001 / consolidated version Decision 568/2009/EC of 18 June 2009
- Started operating on 1 December 2002





Members

All EU Members States with the exception of Denmark, i.e. the contact points provide support in cross-border judicial proceedings relating to another EU Member State



Modus operandi of the EJN Contact Points



The Contact Points

- ...identify solutions for problems with judicial cooperation in civil and commercial matters
 - Direct, swift, and informal mode of operation via e-mail and telephone
 - ➤ Help with problems arising in pending cases <u>only</u> for courts (judges and court staff) and judicial authorities
- ...provide information



Frequent queries and examples how the EJN facilitates cross-border cooperation



- Help with cross-border requests
 - Upon a request for service of a judicial document the transmitting agency receives neither an acknowledgment of receipt nor a certificate of service
 - ➤ The execution of a request for the direct taking of evidence is refused for unclear reasons
 - Information authority does not provide account information pursuant to Art. 14 EAPO-Regulation
 - Many other queries relating to specific cross-border cases!
- Get information where documents establishing execution of a request are unclear
 - ➤ E.g. the information containded in the form (provided for by the respective Regulation) leaves room for interpretation
- Get information on another Member States' applicable law
 - Basic information on the national law of other Member States
- Finding the competent authority abroad


How to reach us best?




European Judicial Atlas in civil matters (Communication of the Member States)
